- Board of Directors of 18 people representing all facets of social, economic and political life in Meath

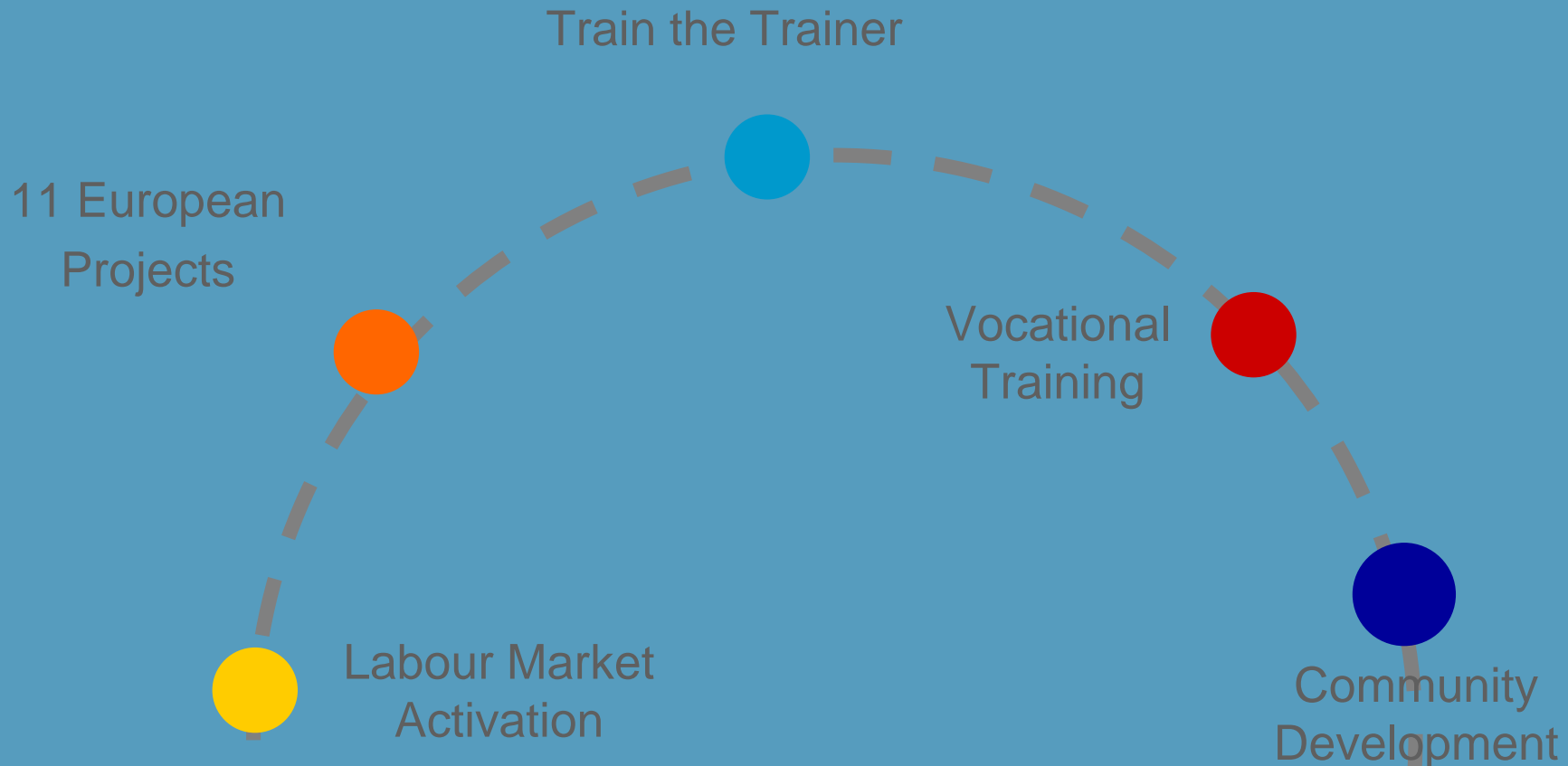
